It is the policy of BR&R to use best practices to reduce carcinogen exposure


- MANDATORY USE OF SCBA FROM INITIAL FIRE ATTACK TO COMPLETION OF OVERHAUL
- SYSTEMATICALLY DECONTAMINATION ALL PPE POST IDLH
- PERSONNEL SHOULD MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO KEEP APPARATUS CABS FROM BEING CONTAMINATED BY PRODUCTS OF COMBUSTIONS
- Gross Decontamination takes place on scene, crews are required to have extra uniform items to change into.
- EVERY LINE MEMBER HAS A SECOND SET OF TURNOUT GEAR
- EVERY STATION HAS A COMMERCIAL WASHING MACHINE TO CLEAN CONTAMINATED GEAR

POST FIRE INCIDENT:

- LOGISTICS PERSONNEL RESPOND WITH REHAB BUS WITH REPLACEMENT HOODS AND GLOVES
- TRUCK AND HEAVY RESCUE HAVE TANK LESS HOT WATER SHOWERS. "SHOWER WITHIN AN HOUR"
